# **Tensioning Cylinder Incident**

#### Issue

Should the portable torque guide's (PTG) hydraulic tensioner cylinders lose pressure, the PTG cables may become slack, possibly causing the hydraulic cylinders to pivot toward the PTG track and collide with the top drive.

### **Affected Units**

All (PTG) portable torque guides.

## **Recommended Inspection**

Canrig recommends checking the following before usage of the PTG tensioner:




Figure 1: Hydraulic tensioner cylinder

1. Inspect for safety securement of the PTG, including the cylinder clevis pin and anti-rotation slider for securement, as shown in Figure 1.

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2. Check the pressure at the TPA port on the tensioner valve manifold to ensure the pressure is set at 2,150 psi when installed.

NOTICE

Valve pressure is pre-set by Canrig. Do not exceed the recommended pressure setting indicated.






Figure 2: Tensioner manifold assembly

3. Inspect the hoses and fittings connecting the tensioner manifold assembly and tensioner hydraulic cylinders for damage or wear.



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4. Inspect the PTG to ensure all the torque guide sections 1 through 5 are within 1/8" maximum alignment across the joints with a level tool.

NOTICE

To determine flat horizontal surfaces between each section of the portable torque guide, refer to the work instruction document ENG 50602.




Figure 3: Torque guide section



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- 5. After Steps 1 through 4 conditions have been verified, the tensioner cylinders can be retracted for tensioning of the PTG tension cables.




Figure 4: Guide runner wear inspection

- 6. When the top drive is installed and laying flat, inspect to ensure the overall gap is an 1/8" to 3/16" (3.2 mm to 4.8 mm) between the front or rear guide runners and the portable torque guide rails, (see Figure 4).

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### **Recommended Modification**

As a precaution, the following modification can be performed to ensure the hydraulic tensioner cylinder remains clear of the guide runners if the hydraulic cylinders fail during operation.





Figure 5: Tensioner modification








Figure 6: Tensioner modification detail




Figure 7: Anti-rotation slider plate modification

For additional safety securement (Part C) pad-eye can be welded to the anti-rotation slider. After welding (Part C) to the anti-rotation slider, secure the anti-rotation slider to the existing carabiner using 1/8" wire and ferrules as shown in Figure 7.




Figure 8: Part C Safety securement tab for the anti-rotation slider




Figure 9: Part B Cylinder guide plate



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
